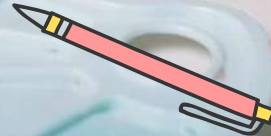

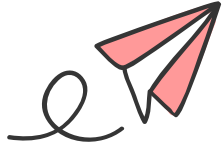

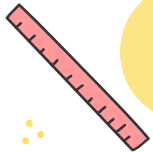

The NCS Primary Wing also places a **great emphasis on discipline and character building**.

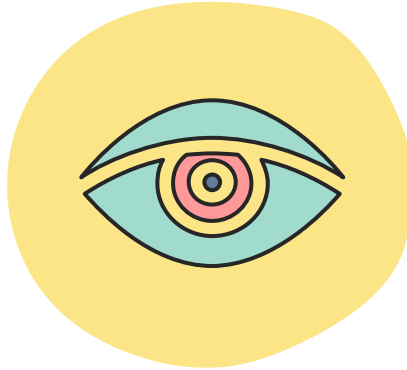
